

# C-DAC eSign Process Improvement Help Manual

## Purpose:

The C-DAC eSign services have been updated to improve security. The goal is to ensure the name used for signing (C-DAC) matches the user's Aadhaar name, which will then be reflected in the signature stamp on certificates.

## Step-by-Step Procedure

### 1. Initial Profile Verification

- After logging in, a window will appear.



- Click on the 'Verify' button to begin the profile update process.

### 2. Updating User Profile

- Clicking 'Verify' will redirect you to the 'User profile page'.


- **Update Name:** Your name must be updated to match the name exactly as it appears on your **Aadhaar** card.
- **Consent:** Select the checkbox as indicated in the system image to provide the necessary verification consent.

### 3. Process for Different Users

- Architects, developers, and officers can use this process to sign various certificates, including:
  - Plan PDFs
  - Commencement certificates
  - Occupancy certificates
  - Plinth certificates


### 4. First-Time Sign-In

- First-time users must select the '**Aadhar**' option under the 'C-DAC e-sign services' section when signing a certificate.




## 5. Handling Sign Failure

- If the **Profile name** and **Aadhaar name** do not match, the system will display a '**Sign failure**' window. Ensure both names are identical to proceed.



## 6. UID Generation for Future Use

- Once the initial steps (1-4) are completed, a **UID number** is automatically generated.
- For future signing, you will not need to enter your Aadhaar number every time. Instead, select the '**UID**' option.



## 7. Finalizing the Signature

- After selecting the 'UID' option, click the '**Get OTP**' button.
- You will receive an OTP on your **Aadhaar-registered mobile number**.
- Enter the OTP and click '**Submit**' to complete the signing process on the specified certificate.
